

## User Guide to Documents and Levels



**Level 1** For first timers: Use this audit to see how your school is currently situated with regards caring for our common home. Once completed submit and receive level 1 certification. You are now ready to undertake the level 2 challenge

**Level 2** For schools already doing good things. Create an action plan based on the data you collected during the level 1 self-Evaluation. Look at the Self-Evaluation tool to help you understand what is required and work backwards from that.
